

Elevate Your Research Deanship: Achieve Excellence with RDA Accreditation

ROADMAP FOR RESEARCH DEANSHIPS TO ACHIEVE RDA ACCREDITATION (3-6 MONTHS)

This roadmap outlines steps and requirements for research deanships to embark on the journey towards Accreditation under the Accreditation Program for Research Deanships (RDA). The estimated timeframe is 3-6 months, but may vary depending on your available resources and starting point.

STAGE 1: SELF-ASSESSMENT AND PREPARATION (MONTH 1-2)

STAGE 4: ACCREDITATION DECISION AND FEEDBACK (MONTH 4-5)

- **Review Committee Deliberation:** The RDA Accreditation Committee will convene to review the peer review reports, self-assessment documents, and all submitted evidence.
- Accreditation Decision: The committee will issue a final decision on your deanship's accreditation status (Accredited, Accredited with Conditions, or Not Accredited).
- **Feedback Report:** You will receive a detailed feedback report explaining the committee's decision and providing recommendations for further improvement, if applicable.

STAGE 5: CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT AND MAINTENANCE (MONTH 5-6)

- Action Plan Implementation: Develop and implement an action plan based on the feedback received to address any shortcomings and maintain compliance with the RDA standards.
